The District Agenda is comprised of four different sections:

The meeting will begin at 9:30 a.m. CST with the first section called Business Administration. The Business Administration section contains items that require the review and approval of the District Board of Supervisors as a normal course of business. The second section is called Business Items. The business items section contains items for approval by the District Board of Supervisors that may require discussion, motion and votes on an item-by-item basis. If any member of the audience would like to speak on one of the business items, they will need to register with the District Administrator prior to the presentation of that agenda item. Occasionally, certain items for decision within this section are required by Florida Statute to be held as a Public Hearing. During the Public Hearing portion of the agenda item, each member of the public will be permitted to provide one comment on the issue, prior to the Board of Supervisors' discussion, motion and vote. Agendas can be reviewed by contacting the Manager's office at (813) 397-5120 at least seven days in advance of the scheduled meeting. Requests to place items on the agenda must be submitted in writing with an explanation to the District Manager at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of the meeting. The third section is called **Staff Reports**. This section allows the District Administrator, Engineer, and Attorney to update the Board of Supervisors on any pending issues that are being researched for Board action. The final section is called Supervisor Requests and Audience Comments. This is the section in which the Supervisors may request Staff to prepare certain items in an effort to meet residential needs. The Audience Comment portion of the agenda is where individuals may comment on matters that concern the District. Each individual is limited to three (3) minutes for such comment. The Board of Supervisors or Staff is not obligated to provide a response until sufficient time for research or action is warranted. IF THE COMMENT CONCERNS A MAINTENANCE RELATED ITEM, THE ITEM WILL NEED TO BE ADDRESSED BY THE DISTRICT ADMINSTRATOR OUTSIDE THE CONTEXT OF THIS MEETING.

Public workshops sessions may be advertised and held in an effort to provide informational services. These sessions allow staff or consultants to discuss a policy or business matter in a more informal manner and allow for lengthy presentations prior to scheduling the item for approval. Typically no motions or votes are made during these sessions.

Pursuant to provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act, any person requiring special accommodations to participate in this meeting is asked to advise the District Office at (813) 397-5120, at least 48 hours before the meeting. If you are hearing or speech impaired, please contact the Florida Relay Service at 1 (800) 955-8770, who can aid you in contacting the District Office.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE HAMMOCK BAY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT DECLARING A VACANCY IN SEATS 2 AND 3 ON THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS PURSUANT TO SECTION 190.006(3)(b), FLORIDA STATUTES; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Hammock Bay Community Development District (the "District") is a local unit of special purpose government created and existing pursuant to Chapter 190, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 2016, two (2) members of the Board of Supervisors (the "Board") are to be elected by the Qualified Electors of the District, as that term is defined in section 190.003, *Florida Statutes*; and

WHEREAS, the District published a notice of qualifying period set by the Supervisor of Elections at least two (2) weeks prior to the start of said qualifying period; and

WHEREAS, at the close of the qualifying period, no Qualified Electors qualified to run for the two (2) seats available for election by the Qualified Electors of the District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 190.006(3)(b), *Florida Statutes*, if no elector qualifies for a seat to be filled in an election, the Board shall declare the seats vacant, effective the second Tuesday following the general election; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 190.006(3)(b), *Florida Statutes*, Qualified Electors are to be appointed to the such vacant seats within ninety (90) days thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt this Resolution declaring the seats available for election as vacant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE HAMMOCK BAY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT:

SECTION 1. The following seats on the District Board are hereby declared vacant effective as of December 13, 2016:

Seat # 3 (currently held by Tim Edwards)

SECTION 2. Until such time as the District Board nominates Qualified Electors to fill the vacancies declared in Section 1 above, the incumbent Board members of those respective seats, if any, shall remain in office.

BUDGET INTRODUCTION

Background Information

The Hammock Bay Community Development District is a local special purpose government authorized by Chapter 190, Florida Statutes, as amended. The Community Development District (CDD) is an alternative method for planning, financing, acquiring, operating and maintaining community-wide infrastructure in master planned communities. The CDD also is a mechanism that provides a "solution" to the State's needs for delivery of capital infrastructure to service projected growth without overburdening other governments and their taxpayers. CDDs represent a major advancement in Florida's effort to manage its growth effectively and efficiently. This allows the community to set a higher standard for construction along with providing a long-term solution to the operation and maintenance of community facilities.

The following report represents the District budget for Fiscal Year 2018, which begins on October 1, 2017. The District budget is organized by fund to segregate financial resources and ensure that the segregated resources are used for their intended purpose, and the District has established the following funds.

Facilities of the District

The District's existing facilities include storm-water management (lake and water control structures), wetland preserve areas, street lighting, landscaping, entry signage, entry features, irrigation distribution facilities, recreational center, parks, pool facility, tennis courts and other related public improvements.

Maintenance of the Facilities

In order to maintain the facilities, the District conducts hearings to adopt an operating budget each year. This budget includes a detailed description of the maintenance program along with an estimate of the cost of the program. The funding of the maintenance budget is levied as a non-ad valorem assessment on your property by the District Board of Supervisors.

District Engineer

Requirements for engineering services are estimated annual expenditures on as needed basis and also cover such items as attendance at scheduled meetings of the Board of Supervisor's, contract preparation and review, etc.

Disclosure Report

This is required of the District as part of the bond indentures.

Trustees Fees

This is required of the District as part of the bond indentures.

Management & Accounting Ser

As part of the consulting managers contract, the District retains Accounting Services to process invoices, prepare tax-rolls and record the District's transactions in compliance with governmental accounting standards.

Auditing Services

The District is required to annually undertake an independent examination of its books, records and accounting procedures. This audit is conducted pursuant to State Law and the Rules of the Auditor General.

Arbitrage Rebate Calculation

This is required of the District as part of the bond indentures.

Postage, Phone, Faxes, Copies

Cost of materials and service to produce agendas and conduct day-to-day business of the District.

Professional Liability Insurance

The District carries Public Officials Liability in the amount of \$1,000,000.

Legal Advertising

This is required to conduct the official business of the District in accordance with the Sunshine Law and other advertisement requirements as indicated by the Florida Statutes.

Bank Fees

The District operates a checking account for expenditures and receipts.

Dues, Licenses & Fees

The District is required to file with the County and State each year.

Miscellaneous Fees

To provide for unbudgeted administrative expenses.

Capital Outlay

This is to purchase new equipment as required.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HAMMOCK BAY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT THAT:

Section 1.	<u>is</u>	hereby	designated	as	the	public

- <u>Section 2.</u> In accordance with Section 280.17(2), *Florida Statutes*, the District's Secretary is directed to take the following steps:
 - (a) Ensure that the name of the District is on the account or certificate or other form provided to the District by the qualified public depository in a manner sufficient to identify that the account is a Florida public deposit.
 - (b) Execute the form prescribed by the Chief Financial Officer for identification of each public deposit account and obtain acknowledgment of receipt on the form from the qualified public depository at the time of opening the account.
 - (c) Maintain the current public deposit identification and acknowledgment form as a valuable record.
- **Section 3.** The District's Treasurer, upon assuming responsibility for handling the funds of the District, is directed to furnish to the State Chief Financial Officer annually, not later than

November 30 of each year, the information required in accordance with Section 280.17(6), *Florida Statutes*, and otherwise take the necessary steps to ensure that all other requirements of Section 280.17, *Florida Statutes*, have been met.

Section 4. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

Hammock Bay Community Development District ("Client") has requested that we prepare certain computations related to the above-described Bonds for the period ended February 26, 2016 ("Computation Period"). The scope of our engagement consisted of the preparation of computations to determine the Rebate Amount for the Bonds for the Computation Period as described in Section 148(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended ("Code"), and this report is not to be used for any other purpose.

In order to prepare these computations, we were provided by the Client with and have relied upon certain closing documents for the Bonds and investment earnings information on the proceeds of the Bonds during the Computation Period. The attached schedule is based upon the aforementioned information provided to us. The assumptions and computational methods we used in the preparation of the schedule are described in the Summary of Notes, Assumptions, Definitions and Source Information. A brief description of the schedule is also attached.

The results of our computations indicate a negative Cumulative Rebate Amount of \$(1,174,643.18) at February 26, 2016. As such, no amount must be on deposit in the Rebate Fund.

Also, as the Bonds were defeased on February 26, 2016, no further rebate calculations will be necessary.

As specified in the Form 8038-G, the calculations have been performed based upon a Bond Yield of 5.8224%. Accordingly, we have not recomputed the Bond Yield.

The scope of our engagement was limited to the preparation of a mathematically accurate Rebate Amount for the Bonds for the Computation Period based on the information provided to us. The Rebate Amount has been determined as described in the Code, and regulations promulgated thereunder ("Regulations"), as applicable to the Bonds and in effect on the date of this report. We have no obligation to update this report because of events occurring, or information coming to our attention, subsequent to the date of this report.

- 3. Computations of yield are based upon a 30-day month, a 360-day year and semiannual compounding.
- 4. We have assumed that the only funds and accounts relating to the Bonds that are subject to rebate under section 148(f) of the Code are shown in the attached schedule.
- 5. For investment cash flow purposes, all payments and receipts are assumed to be paid or received, respectively, as shown in the attached schedule. In determining the Rebate Amount for the Bonds, we have relied on information provided by you without independent verification, and we can therefore express no opinion as to the completeness or suitability of such information for such purposes. In addition, we have undertaken no responsibility to review the tax exempt status of interest on the Bonds.
- 6. We have assumed that the purchase and sale prices of all investments as represented to us are at fair market value, exclusive of brokerage commissions, administrative expenses, or similar expenses, and representative of arms' length transactions that did not artificially reduce the Rebate Amount for the Bonds, and that no "prohibited payments" occurred and no "imputed receipts" are required with respect to the Bonds.
- 7. Ninety percent (90%) of the Rebate Amount as of the next "computation date" ("Next Computation Date") is due to the United States Treasury not later than 60 days thereafter ("Next Payment Date"). (An issuer may select any date as a computation date, as long as the first computation date is not later than five years after the issue date, and each subsequent computation date is no more than five years after the previous computation date.) No other payment of rebate is required prior to the Next Payment Date. The Rebate Amount as of the Next Computation Date will not be the Rebate Amount reflected herein, but will be based on future computations that will include the period ending on the Next Computation Date. If all of the Bonds are retired prior to what would have been the Next Computation Date, one hundred percent (100%) of the unpaid Rebate Amount computed as of the date of retirement will be due to the United States Treasury not later than 60 days thereafter.
- 8. For purposes of determining what constitutes an "issue" under section 148(f) of the Code, we have assumed that the Bonds constitute a single issue and are not required to be aggregated with any other bonds.

- 9. The accrual basis of accounting has been used to calculate earnings on investments. Earnings accrued but not received at the last day of the Computation Period are treated as though received on that day. For investments purchased at a premium or a discount (if any), amortization or accretion is included in the earnings accrued at the last day of the Computation Period. Such amortization or accretion is computed in such a manner as to result in a constant rate of return for such investment. This is equivalent to the "present value" method of valuation that is described in the Regulations.
- 10. No provision has been made in this report for any debt service fund. Under section 148(f)(4)(a) of the Code, a "bona fide debt service fund" for public purpose bonds issued after November 10, 1988 is not subject to rebate if the average maturity of the issue of bonds is at least five years and the rates of interest on the bonds are fixed at the issue date. It appears and has been assumed that the debt service fund allocable to the Bonds qualifies as a bona fide debt service fund, and that this provision applies to the Bonds.
- 11. In order to prepare the Arbitrage Calculation we have relied on prior arbitrage report by Deloitte Tax LLP with respect to the Rebate Amount Liability as of October 31, 2011.

- 1. *Bond Year*: Each one-year period that ends on the day selected by the Client. The first and last Bond Years may be shorter periods.
- 2. *Bond Yield*: The yield that, when used in computing the present value (at the issue date of the Bonds) of all scheduled payments of principal and interest to be paid over the life of the Bonds, produces an amount equal to the Issue Price.
- 3. *Allowable Earnings*: The amount that would have been earned if all nonpurpose investments were invested at a rate equal to the Bond Yield, which amount is determined under a future value method described in the Regulations.
- 4. *Computation Date Credit*: A credit allowed by the Regulations as a reduction to the Rebate Amount on certain prescribed dates.
- 5. *Rebate Amount*: The excess of actual earnings over Allowable Earnings and Computation Date Credits.
- 6. *Issue Price*: Generally, the initial offering price at which a substantial portion of the Bonds is sold to the public. For this purpose, 10% is a substantial portion.




